From Natchez to Meridian

Travel to Jackson, MS. Take I-20 East to Meridian and take exit 153 (22nd Ave) to the right. At the light, turn left onto 22nd Ave North. Stay on 22nd Ave and go thru the 14th traffic light keeping straight to the 4-way stop. Turn right on 14th Street and turn left at the first traffic light. Keep straight to the stop sign and turn left, merge into the parking garage. Enter the building at the glass enclosure on the Ground Level. Walk down the incline and turn left. The Auditorium is the 1st door on the left.

From Jackson to Meridian

Take I-20 East to Meridian and take exit 153 (22nd Ave) to the right. At the light, turn left onto 22nd Ave North. Stay on 22nd Ave and go thru the 14th traffic light keeping straight to the 4-way stop. Turn right on 14th Street and turn left at the first traffic light. Turn right on 14th Street and turn left at the first traffic light. Keep straight to the stop sign and turn left, merge into the parking garage. From Laurel/Hattiesburg to Meridian

Take I-59 North to Meridian and merge to I-20 East. Once on I-20 East, take exit 153 (22nd Ave) to the right. At the light, turn left onto 22nd Ave North. Stay on 22nd Ave and go thru the 14th traffic light keeping straight to the 4-way stop. Turn right on 14th Street and turn left at the first traffic light. Keep straight to the stop sign and turn left, merge into the parking garage. Enter the building at the glass enclosure on the Ground Level. Walk down the incline and turn left.
